Ninety percent of our education program costs are funded by donors like you. Without you, 567 students would not have access to in-class music instruction as part of their curriculum. In the coming year, H+H looks to expand partnerships with more Boston Public Schools and increase participation in H+H Youth Choruses. For the very first time, we are providing dual-language classes as well and developing more Spanish language materials for students and their families.
