With you on our side, the Pennsylvania SPCA will never say no to innocent victims of cruelty or neglect.

There were 74 timid, scared tails tucked between legs. 148 gleaming eyes assessing us, wondering if we were there to help them, 296 paws anxiously pacing the floor, looking for a clean or empty place to lie down.

What started as a quiet Thursday evening at the Pennsylvania SPCA changed in an instant. Local police were serving a routine order at a home when

they noticed what they thought were approximately 40 dogs living in unsanitary conditions.

Police quickly called our Animal Law Enforcement team, and when our officers arrived, we were shocked to discover that the actual number of neglected dogs on this property was 74.

This herd of all chihuahuas and one rottweiler mix was surrendered to the Pennsylvania SPCA by the owner, who is facing charges of neglect.
